ENTRIES

This event is pre-entry online via Online only- (BMXA user name & password required)

Racing will be conducted under BMXA current Australian rulebook. Rules 12.1(a); 12.2(a); Three (3) registered riders constitute a class. Gender equity applies.

All classes will be determined by Year of Birth. A current licence or BMXA receipt must be shown at registration. This Event will be scored using Mylaps Transponders. Random scrutineering may be conducted at this event.

Prize money breakdown as per BMXA current Australian rulebook- 79.

No Alcohol, Smoking or pets allowed within the BMX precinct.

VENUE: Rockhampton Bmx Club, Hollingsworth Street, North Rockhampton Qld

CONDITION OF ENTRY: These Championships are open to all *Central Queensland Licenced Riders* (e.g. you must be licenced to a club within the Central Queensland zone, excluding superclass).

LATE NOMINATIONS: Late nominations will only be accepted at the discretion of the Registrar to keep in line with COVID restrictions and no later than the **7th of October** and will be entered into existing classes. No new classes will be formed. A late payment fee of \$20.00 will be charged.
