BMX Queensland is proud to deliver the 2020 BMX Tracks Australia BMX Queensland State Development Series with the emphasis on our emerging riders developing their racing against quality competition across the state, supporting clubs in every zone, culminating at the State Championships.

This event is for all classes as per the current Australian Rule Book.

Round 1 Townsville ID the 11 & 12 of April 2020

Round 2 Qld City Challenge, Nerang the 2 of May 2020 **Double Points**

Round 3 Rockhampton ID the 16 & 17 of May 2020

Round 4 Qld Country Challenge, Harbour City the 27 of June 2020 **Double Points**

Round 5 Mackay the 18 of July 2020

Round 6 Atherton the 1 of August 2020

Round 7 Sarina the 15 of August 2020

Round 8 State Championships, Ipswich the 21-26 of September 2020 **Double Points**

To Qualify: You must compete at the 2020 State Championships, plus a minimum of 3 additional events.

SERIES AWARDS

**All 20" and Cruiser classes to get Presentation Plates 1 to 8 for the State Series, presentation to be held at the State Championships.
(excludes sprockets and participation classes)**

\$1,000 prize pool, per class for 20" Men 14, 15, 16, 17-24 year.

\$1,000 prize pool, per class for 20" Women 14, 15, 16, 17-24 year.

(Total prize pool \$8,000)

\$1,500 prize pool per Superclass Men.

\$1,500 prize pool per Superclass Women.

(Total prize pool \$3,000)

Prize Pool Breakdown 1st 50%, 2nd 30%, 3rd 20%

Prize money as per Rule 79 of current Australian rule Book

An additional \$5.00 will be applicable for all entries at these events, Sprockets and participation classes excluded. This is not a separate event from the event at which it will be held. The points will be calculated based on the results achieved at these events in the actual classes entered. In the event of a tie the results at the State Championships will determine the place. The best 3 results plus that of the state titles will be used to determine individuals placing. Race formats will be as per the technical guides for each individual event. All racing will be as per the current BMXA rule Book.



State Development Series Points calculation.

Series Points from each round of the 2020 BMX Tracks Australia BMX Queensland State Development Series will be awarded as per the following table:

- Place refers to the rider's place in their **entered class**. Where two or more classes are merged, results of the combined classes are split back into the original, separate classes.
- Points are awarded from the above table based on ranking within the class after the Final.
- Double Points Rounds: Double the points listed in the table above will be awarded at the designated rounds.
- Series Qualification and end of Series Awards are determined by:

Riders must enter and compete in a minimum of 4 of the 8 rounds, the State Championships is compulsory in order to qualify for the SDS points in that class. Points from the best 4 rounds count towards series total.

- In the event of a tie, the higher placed rider at the State Championships will determine the final order.
- Offered Classes as per the Current Australia Rule Book.
